Introduction:

This set was created using version 2.15. You must have the most current version of *ADC2* to use this module. You can download the newest version of *ADC2* from WWW.hpssims.com or contact **HPS** direct.

Working knowledge of *Aide de Camp 2* is a pre-requisite for using this module.

As with all computer programs, it is strongly suggested that you save often.

Getting Started:

Create a folder called “Caldiero” for your module in the “Game Sets” sub-folder of the *ADC2* folder. Extract the contents of the module into this folder. The entire set takes about 12 megabytes of space.

There is only one scenario in the game and in this module.

Log in as either the French or Austrian player.

Setting Up To Play:

The units that begin play on the map are located in the appropriate hex. . The units to be brought on as reinforcements are located in Force Pools with names corresponding to the turn and side of the reinforcing units.

Markers have been made with the same functions they have in the board game. They are placed in the pools to start.

Class and Piece Values:

Class Values

1. Combat Strength
2. Initiative

For Commanders, their Initiative is preceeded by a “C”

For Officers, their initiative is preceeded by an “R”

3. Movement Allowance

The map and terrain is reproduced as it is in the game.

Flip Sides:

Flip sides are defined for all units and correspond to the board game.

In making this module, I had several conversations with Enrico about the intended organization of the commands for the two sides, especially the French. As a result, there have been some changes and clarifications to the counter designations of some units. The French organization is listed below:
